Fine gathered 9 pails sawing stove wood
2 of Benshaws here brought home the umbrella
a good lot of shooting to day on the
South side killed a snake yesterday
Bad with my shoulders water falling
I went to the Lower point Seander to Park
Bought a can of Mustard 19th fine E
Boiled down what Sap there was
4 Gallons a lot of shooting to day
Peter Back here fishing Eels got
some nails to the his sail frogs
making music Kingsher came
lots of Dead Perch in Back Bay
20th E Wind and West cutting stove wood
EEL fishers Seander to Lancaster

on the 21st of April

Carlo here a year ago to day
Eddy Kershaw here 24th very fine
Princes Louise first night Cornwall
Gordon Hewing the Elm pieces up
set the camp The Chaffer into
Lancaster to night 25th E Wind
Day a very fine Day East and West
Wind in the evening Thunde and lightning
some drops of Rain Lewis and 2 of
his children here got Milk Gordon
crossed Hewed the oaks ploughing
the Potato ground a Steam Barge
went Down this Morning Dred some
Flores to the Bank
