Mr Daniels Cannon Island Oct 21<sup>st</sup>  
Working at Day 22<sup>nd</sup> Colouring Cotton for Quilts 23<sup>rd</sup>  
Virginia Birth Day 1868 11 years old to Day Quilling 24<sup>th</sup>  
Our H. H. H's Birth Day 25<sup>th</sup> My 13<sup>th</sup> Day  
Cleaning out the Big shed Dan Summers here to night  
and a Passenger from Lancaster almost 70<sup>th</sup> that  
man with him have him an old stone pipe hat  
26<sup>th</sup> 2 men camped on the Rte Point from Prescott  
one of them keeps a Livery of Boats they are Hunting  
Dicks 27<sup>th</sup> Luke Bowen and another man here  
they have a Steam Yacht at the foot of Chester  
Island covering the shed with marsh hay 28<sup>th</sup>  
My Derushee the Fisherman went to the store sent  
for Soda 1 lb. 2 spools of Thread 25<sup>th</sup> Drawing wood  
out of the Marsh Back of the sugar Bush for  
Sugar Bush Wood the Barges the Maxwell  
Run aground some yrs ago got off to Day  
30<sup>th</sup> Mr Blenwa wanting the Grapes to make  
wine 31<sup>st</sup> H & by Eve, Drawing Wood cracking  
nuts 1<sup>st</sup> of November All Mists & fog  
Amiot here for nuts got a nice Bag from  
him Drew the old Man some wood 2<sup>nd</sup> Sunday  
Gordon and Tommy Rose here sent some  
Tobacco to Andrew Rose East Wind began  
to blow through the night Put in the calves  
tonight and 1<sup>st</sup> of May, 3<sup>rd</sup> East Wind snowing  
and Blowing hard Shelling the corn nubbings  
to Day all the Best of the corn Shelled before this  
the cattle all went to the head of the Island with  
the East wind Went up for the cattle as its  
very stormy Feeding the cattle 4<sup>th</sup> Drew some  
Wood the old Man Mr Derushee for onions  
5<sup>th</sup> Guy Fawkes Day Sharpened the same  
Mr Derushee the Fisherman to Lancaster sent for  
Geese and Corn, taking up the Grapes  
sawing Stone Wood Salmon River  
of note as the Merrry has hard work to Break

Mr Daniels Cannon Island Nov 6<sup>th</sup> 1873  
Cold some drew some Drags & hastening the Stables  
Reling up Firewood feed Royal Charlie the Bull  
in the big shed lots of shooting to the south side  
of Harbor Went down to the Kit Kit Island Randolph  
and I took some fat pine my old pitch Salt Water  
very low East Wind lots of shooting the Alexandria  
went up very slow & some Done snowing  
H. H. H's Birth Day 8<sup>th</sup> Regt. Model  
with the yarn paid her to day 5 cents and  
gave her 50 cents when we brought the  
wool to her 6<sup>th</sup> of Nov Drew some wood  
Brought the sheep from the Bush  
Amiot came from Cornwall where he was  
fishing lost a hope from him and goes to  
Market Bohemian came straight up  
did not go into Lancaster its on account  
of the water being so low 9<sup>th</sup> Sunday fine  
Blowing hard Rainy 10<sup>th</sup> Cutting Drags  
and Drawing Wood 11<sup>th</sup> Blanking the east  
end of the House cut some marsh hay  
for the Blanking 12<sup>th</sup> Old Hollow wood  
at the Martin's Blanking 13<sup>th</sup> Went for a Bush  
of cedar Amiot making blinds for his  
The steamer of Avonell went off  
to Day Wind high 14<sup>th</sup> Amiot and Henry went  
off 15<sup>th</sup> Raining Making Decoy Heads 16<sup>th</sup> Sunday  
went around the Island Bismarck and I 17<sup>th</sup>  
Gabriel Derushee took up his lines he had him  
with them fishing the porch took up Boards  
that Amiot left 18<sup>th</sup> snowing stormy East W  
Chopping Stone Wood helped the old man  
with his nets packing them up 19<sup>th</sup> Mr Derushee  
went off helped him with his sturgeon and  
Kickerel Load up his boat left his Burn  
ore and chest and rods turned stormy  
tonight drift W Wind snowing
