 out of the Marsh Back of the Sugar Bush for
 Sugar Bush Wood the Barges the Maxwell
 Run a ground some time ago got off to Day
 30th Nov. Blauwa wanting the grapes to make
 wine 31st Nov. by Eve Drawing Wood Cracking
 nuts 1st of November (all Mints Day)
 Amiot here for nuts Got a Nice Bul from
 him Drew the old Man some wood 2nd Sunday
 Gordon and Tommy Rote here sent some
 Tobacco to Andrew Rose East Wind 13th began
 to snow through the night Pile in the calves
 to night and 1st Morn. 3rd East Wind snowing
 and Blowing hard Shelling the corn nibblings
 to Day all the Best of the corn shelled before this
 the Cattle all went to the head of the Island with
 the East Wind Went up for the Cattle as its
 very stormy Feeding the Cattle 4th Drew some
 Wood the old Man Mr Derushie for onions
 5th by Day 5th Day sharpened the saw
 Mr Derushie the Fisherman to Lancaster sent for
 Yea and Combs taking up the Grapes
 Sawing stove Wood Salmon River
 of iron as the Merry has hard work to break

 very Low East Wind Lots of Shelling the Alexander
 went up very slow Fine Day snowing
 Holland Birth Day 8th Rezz. Rodell
 with the yarn paid 12 to Day 5 cents and
 gave her 50 cents when we brought the
 wool to her 6th lb. of Wool Drew some wood
 brought the sheep from the Bush
 Amiot came from Cornwall where he was
 fishing lot a Rope from him and got some
 Wake R. Bohemian came straight up
 did not go into Lancaster its on account
 of the water being so Low 9th Sunday Fine
 Blowing Hard Raining 10th Cutting Spags
 and Drawing Wood 11th Blanking the East
 end of the House Cut some Marsh Hay
 for the Bunking 12th Mr Hallow Eve of
 St. Martin's Blanking 13th Went for a Beam
 of Cedar Amiot making Blinds for Duns
 The steamer of Avilla went off
 to Day Wind high 14th Amiot and Mory went
 off 15th Raining Making Decoy heads 16th Sunday
 went round the Island (Bismarck and 17th
 Gabriel Derushie took up his Lines he had him
 with them Fencing the porch took up Boards
 that Amiot left 18th snowing Stormy East W
 Chopping stove Wood helped the old Man
 with his Nets packing them up 19th Mr Derushie
 went off helped him with his Sturgeon and
 Rickerel Load up his Boat left when Sum
 ore and chest and Rods turned stormy
 it night with W Wind snowing
