Treatment of Fistula in Ano.

When much pus is being discharged, or a large abscess is present, an operation for fistula in ano should not be performed. The proper treatment is to insure free drainage, if necessary, by enlarging the existing openings for the purpose, and to have the tracks and pockets frequently irrigated with hydrogen peroxide, or some other suitable antiseptic solution. Frequently fomentations and hot baths will also assist. All this saves time in the end, as it much reduces the size of the wound required at operation.—Mummery; Lancet.
