- June 6 Monday. raining this afternoon. we took cows No 1. & 3 to C Bayles bull.
- June 7 Tuesday. doing chores. took milk 260 lbs to Factory. got wagon ready. & started to draw logs to Rouses mill. for father. Paid Sam Doherty. for shoeing 900 horse. all round. 150¢. very nice day.
- June 8 Wednesday. doing chores took milk to factory. 185 lbs. drew two loads of logs to mill. & one load of lumber home. sent letter to H.E.P. at night. masons finished second story of house to-day. & started cornells. house
- June 9. Thursday. took milk to factory. then went to Rouses mill & got load of lumber. cultivating & sowed fodder corn. next to barn. cultivating in the crop ground.
- June 10 Friday doing chores. took milk to factory. cultivating & harrowing. Read letter from H.E.P.
- June 11 Saturday. Took milk to factory. got ready & went to Hamilton on 9-50 train. & got good. \$14.10 met H.E.P. very wet day. called at Mr Stewarts. S. Plastow also down. with rig.
- June 12 Sunday. doing chores. went to church at night. home all day. met S.A.P. at night & went for walk.
- June 13 Monday. doing chores. working at new house. Father away with team to Troy for lime. & to Capetown with horse to see carpenters.
- June 14 Tuesday. doing chores. doing road work. & drew 1 load stone from
