April 29 continued Thursday forward
 got stormier and windier as day advanced
 snowing and drifting from east, wintry like.
 Willie hauled 2 loads of rails and stakes 50
 rails 50 stakes over to Miss Robinsons place for
 Mr Sars to finish building the fence. I cleaned
 seed oats. P.M. we riddled coals down cellar
 preparatory to getting ready to count and bin.
 Mr Kincaid in P.M. tell us to bring cattle down Saturday.

Fierce wind storm last night thunder
 and lightning Barbers barn burnt, raining
 and hailing and slating trees all coated with
 ice in morning snow all over drifted in
 places cloudy day misty got milder by
 night and thawing considerable. We cleaned
 seed oats and put up pig drop also fixed
 scales and weighed white Star Elma
 1330 lbs wood screw came out of platform
 when weighing red star Gebe. P.M. Willie
 took 10 bags pig drop 94 lbs to Walsons brought
 load measure from 7 ranks to pile then went
 for drop 45 cts. I fixed up another window
 window in P.M. fanning etc.
