20 Fine day. To butter at Willis 35^{cts}. 2 lb raisins 25 Soda 5 Molasses 30^{cts} stove polish 10^{cts} Cough 15^{cts} 4 loaves 20 1 pair of tomatoes 20. Polished the kitchen stove

21 Fine day. Made Kefir To 5 lb steak at Sandys charged. Dennis M Gillivray and daughter Catherine from Walla Walla, Washington Territory came to the village yesterday. They came to see Ford.
