 Girls down town in P.M. Bella stayed down they got at Russell on apr dress goods 5.95 hat 2.25  
 took to Armstrongs 3 lbs butter 72 got groceries 72  
 got from Mrs Wilson butter 95 Mrs Oakes 92  
 Mother up to-day helping gave her 42 cts  
 Willie took rest of wrapped hay over to Lass yesterday got \$4.00 in full paid Thompsons apr 3.25 meat 25

Cloudy; some sunshine ground frozen this morning. Willie went up to Allans for the 2 bushels timothy seed then we took seeder back to No 7 and put on load hay after which Willie harrowed & cultivated the No 7 strip in P.M. we sowed it with barley. Bella came up this evening.

Hard frost last night. got warmer to-day: sunny, warm in P.M. We plowed furrows to let water off No 6 and No 2 and picked stones off No 2 then cultivated and harrowed in No 6. Willie down town at night got at Mennies snaps about 18 at Phelps stuff for home 25 caught traps 5
