Fine sunny day mostly. Willie plowed corn stubble AM. I made gate for pig pen etc. G Irvine up P.M. I plowed corn stubble Willie and S.D. topped turnips we harrowed some out and brought home load on high waggon. Belle and I drove down in evening to B. Smith's meeting in Methodist church. Mr. Hossard of mixed nationality gave a very interesting address also lantern illustration. We gave coll 15cts.

### Wednesday

Fine sunny day warm. I plowed corn stubble and brought over load turnips high waggon and Willie went down town got at F&S sugar etc \$1.28 met Bergins 60 cts gasoline Reuss 46 he brought up F&M they walked down P.M. P.M. 5 I came up he and Willie at turnips in field, S.D. brought over 3 loads in turnip box Willie brought the 4th. I stayed at home put gate on pig pen fixed fence cleaned out root house etc. also helped take off loads. Belle and I went to go to ~~Fordsham~~ <sup>Fordsham</sup> prayer meeting but Mrs. Guss told us it was not to be held to-night so we stayed at Gusses till nine. Got
