Stanley went up with Eddy to Build a Stack

Tying the corn stalks Made Strings of Rope and
standing it up cutting stalks Taking the corn to
husk to night Wrote a Letter to send to Dan
25th East Wind Fine Took up the Early Market
16 Bushels put them in the cellar of the
New house put the corn stalks in the
Stable loft what cut of them an Indian
for Butter finished husking and Tracing
the Corn the Tall Kansas corn is not cut
yet Shelling Beans Cows set for spells in the
upper field Shot a Plover got 2 Rats in the
Cordwood Bay Washing to Day Mascerville
Fair Excursion on the New Railroad
to Ottawa Stanley came from Kershawes

a very fine Day Thunder few Drops of
Rain very hot Sun at the other end of
Potatoes Big Market put in the cellar of the new
House 11 1/2 Bushels to Day Broke the fence
Whippletree The Lady Smith began going
down at night First Trip Heard that
Napoleon Hence got Married to Day
Took Home about 40 Bricks to night
Leander crossed Fernandez crossed Lightning
and Thunder to night old Bricks where
they got them I dont know 27th Fine
Day at the Potatoes the Burbanks Below
East of the House Shelling Beans not
very Well to Day 28th some Drops of Rain Turned
Fine East Wind finished the Pease Below the
all But to Harrow them put 76 of the Burbanks
in the cellar now taking up the Potatoes
at the Maple Trees on the West side Fernandez
to Lancaster
~~for Potatoes 2 Bushel~~
20 cents Keeping the small Potatoes apart for
the Pigs 29th St. Michael Mass Taking
Potatoes Back of the Barn took up
about 13 Bushels to Day say about
110 Bushels in now Raining hard to
Day Salted the cattle a Lot of Shooting
to Day East Wind the Harrowing is to be
done and the East side at the Maple
Trees so there will be some more Potatoes
to be ploughed 30th Fine Leander to night
Church Fernandez crossed a very fine night
Last Day of the Month Heard Adelaide had
a young son Randolph came Home
from New York on Saturday the 29th
(29th a Batch of 10 chickens)
