30 Very hard frost last night again fine day sunny most day. Willie took load turnips down to behario in morning also some straw to D. Strale got turnip ticket 70cts received balance from behario for turnips \$32.90 In PM Wm. Simdale and W. G. Gibson up we pulled turnips Gibson topped some and we got 3 turnip box loads over to barn. 3 horses on wagon. Willie drove down to W.T. at noon got at Armstrongs on a/c coal oil, wheat grain 25 cwt meal 10cts. sold eggs 3cts

Ground all covered with snow this morning misty and cloudy in AM cleared off some in PM a little sunshine. not very cold. W.T. and W.G. came up in morning put in load turnips then went home too slushy. Willie and I pulled turnips in AM. In PM Willie and J. Fernal took in 3 loads turnips J.F. topping between loads I pulled 10 $\frac{3}{4}$ hours in PM Mother up in PM Mary went down with her got at Woods Lamps milk 3cts also goods on a/c (see bill) Willie paid Jim Fernal 15cts. stamps 4cts
