Very hard frost last night again fine day sunny most day. Willie took load turnips down to Lhairie in morning also some straw to D. Strain got turnip ticket 70cts received balance from Lhairie for turnips \$32.90 In P.M. Wm. Indale and Wm. Gibson up we pulled turnips Gibson topped some and we got 3 turnip box loads over to barn. 3 horses on waggons. Willie drove down to W.T. at noon got at Armstrongs on aft coal oilers wheat 25 oat meal 10 cts. and eggs 3cts

Ground all covered with snow this morning misty and cloudy in A.M. cleared off some in P.M. a little sunshine. not very cold. W.T. and W.S. came up in morning put in load turnips then went home too slushy. Willie and I pulled turnips in A.M. In P.M. Willie and J. Fernal took in 3 loads turnips J.F. topping between loads I pulled 10 3/4 rows in P.M. Mother up in P.M. May went down with her got at Woods lamps 3cts also goods on aft (see bill) Willie paid Jim Fernal 15 cts. slamps 4cts
