I had sowed and ran out the one long ditch &
into one tributary. I had Dave's roller & harrow
Tuesday morning I went down to Sid's to have Green shot
as it rained a little Monday night and I thought was too
wet to work on the land. Sid couldn't shoot her then as
he was just starting out to post up Mrs. Marshall's sale
bills so I drove out to Mattias Shilly's to inquire
about a girl that I heard was out there and that he
was going to let go, but she was already spoken for.
I came Wednesday & wash and Wednesday we
got word from the Barnardo's Home saying they had
no girl available at present but advised us to send
in an application together with a fee of \$3.00 and they
would send one as soon as possible. Mary filed

up the application form but as we didn't have the \$3.00
we didn't send it and today Mr. Carter telephoned
down that there was an exceptionally bright looking
Armenian girl 17 years old. in Lunenburg would go out
for \$2.10 a week. so I am to go up on Tuesday next to
interview her. Mary has got on very well all week
with just the baby to look after. Gay has been good down
at Lunenburg we went down town today and I saw that I
brought Mary's bag yesterday for Mary to get a coat
on him that she was making and he is still here.
Mary thinks she can manage him now. Green Man
came over today afternoon and took down his radio
aerial. I drove him back as I was going down to get
some oil chop for the horses. Wednesday night I went down
to hand practice but got fooled again as there was not any.
We have been watching the papers all week for the
arrival of the Mont Royal which is supposed to have
aboard her Mr. Parks and the news of the fortune. Dad had
a very nice personal hand written letter from him this
week saying he expected to sail on the 9th and would
telegraph when he would arrive in Dorset. The boat
will dock at St. John and he said he would probably
travel in the day time as he wants to see the country
