 potatoes on top of ground frozen. Fine in AM  
 clouded in P.M. a few drops rain. Fred  
 Armstrong up in morning helped on with  
 load straw which Willie took down to him  
 Jim Fernal up in P.M. we finished taking  
 up potatoes except some knowings. Willie took  
 his load straw to J. Quinn brought up two  
 loads coal from C. Mattamie. He drove  
 Jim down at night took coal apart with  
 him also buy potatoes for Jim 75 paid him  
 in full balance 75 total \$1.50.

 We spread 10 loads manure (spread) on No 2 W  
 to-day. Mother up in P.M. Willie drove  
 her down in evening got at Menin lamp glass 8 to.  
 Mr and Mrs Lunn and Mrs and Mrs Mutch and  
 Mary over for tea and evening. We lit furnace  
 and the pipe broke fell down and let gas out till  
 we improvised a substitute in place of and old pipe.
