Thurs 5 Mrs Govin came with butter milk Eugene Jubarts boy about 10 year old accidentally shot himself dead with a revolver he took out of his home We ordered a box of 30 lbs of butter at 36 1/2^{cts} from Whyte Pack, Com, Montreal, it arrived today \$16.25 = 35 Express, & Watson got 10 lbs of butter = 15.00 bread 18. Got a mutton ham, by mail, from John 18

Frid 6 Fine day hot - Ann paid 3.00 rent

Sat 7 Milk 42 bread 18 coal oil 25 85

Sun 8 Preaching in afternoon. Memorial service for Gregar Stewart and a home boy (Mellor I think)

Mon 9 Got a receipt from Whyte for \$18.35. Rain

Tues 10 It is still cloudy 2 loaves 18 18

Wed 11 Slight drizzle at times. Muddy went north Farquhar was down gave me 27. Can corn 20 21

Thurs 12 I was for 3 days washing a doz sheets will try and put them out today It rained all day 2 loaves 18

Frid 13 Muddy hung out the sheets

Sat 14 Milk 42, bread 36 Catherine Robertson sent me a fine steak of Salmon, I boiled half of it for tomorrow

Sun 15 General fund 25 Thunder storm about 5 heavy showers

Mon 16 Ann 65^{cts} Mrs Dunlop called. And Flora Ann Christie and Dan took tea with us. Dan expects to take ship on Friday for over seas, he is in the Flying Ace He is looking and feeling well % bread 18

Tues 17 Sold our farm in the 2d Con. North of River Raisin, to Oliver Major for \$200.00 300. down, signed today, interest 6 P.C

Wed 18 Rain all day

Thurs 19 Sent an order to Batons \$10.39-15^{cts} for 11 54 potato & P. Order, 1 qt gooseberries 10 10

Frid 20 Rain

Sat 21 Milk 42, bread 36 - 1 gall coal oil 25 1 03

Sun 22 General fund 25. Missions 2.00 ^{Monday 1 day} 2 25

Mon 23. On Sat 21. I got 1 doz buns from H. Barrette 15 15 And Mrs Govin brought some buttermilk

Tues 24 92 in the shade today

Wed 25 92 "

Thurs 26 1 gall coal oil 25 Still hot

Frid 27 Turned cooler, I gathered about 2 qts of currants, had some in garden 2 loaves 18. I do a little sewing every day 18 60

Sat 28 Milk 42, 2 loaves 18

Sun 29 General fund 25

Mon 30 Ann 65^{cts}

Tues 31 Jimmie and I went to Cornwall by Auto I had my eyes examined by Doan and ordered a pair of glasses \$12.00 for 6 days we have had very hot weather mercury up as high as 94 88 the lowest
