Hernia in Children.

If at the end of two years a measure of improvement is noticeable, and the truss is efficient and worn with comfort, it is wise to persist in the mechanical treatment.

The time for operation has arrived, regardless of age, when no further progress toward a cure can be observed; when the truss is a source of irritation and marked discomfort, and especially when, from the greater activities of the growing child, the truss fails to keep the rupture constantly reduced.—
