and Tyler Lincoln. Stopt in the stable loft till
morning 19th Bismarck's Birth Day 1870
20th Got a Letter from John in Summerstown 21st
Went to Dundee with a Tennet of Butter Bought
of H. K. Baker 16 yds of Cotton 20 yds of Calico 1 1/2 yds of Shawl
3 yds of Wincey 3 yds of Cotton Wincey 8 Bundles of Battin
Thread 16 yds 21 cents Cash got 1 1/2 yds for
what I was short 22nd Writing Fishing shot a Duck
Heavy Rain and Thunder high Wind 23rd Sent a
Letter to John Willie Rose John Hamilton and
I went to the Stone John Trowling have Hamilton
and Willie Rose my Boat to go to Lancaster
put me ashore at the Nor West side of the Stone
they had quite a heavy Wind blowing from
Sunday 24th Land Gordon went to John Hamilton
for the Boat in the Light house 25th Jim
Hopkins came to show took his mowing
Machine along with him we went after the
old horse up to the Black Horse Island
26th Mowing 27th Went to Summerstown got
a paper of Oil and Tea 28th Mr Fenton and
Charlie and Miles Mr Fenton not very
well had some talk with Jim Hopkins
about stneatching in catching Fish 29th
Gathering Hay Mowing 30th put in all the
Hay that's cut Raining Hauling 31st
Fishing Rain and Snow 1st of September
very much High West Wind a great deal of shooting
on the south side 2nd James at Lancaster 3rd
D. M. Mothers Birth Day 1846 Jim Hopkins
and Charlie came to show finished the mowing 4th I went
home East Wind Towed the Pine up with them 5th
To Mr Charters Birth Day 1850 6th Dug a little or nothing

Gordon and I went down to the Red Red Island or Red Island
8th Mowing some 9th put in Hay 10th Mr Fenton and
Mr Bristol and 2 Americans here one of the Americans was
Blanchard the other Mans names I forget I went to
Summerstown Peter Baker married to Day Mr Fenton
left 3/4 11th Mowing 12th Mr Fenton and Mr Spencer here
Windy not very well 13th Putting in Marsh Hay put in
20 Bushels of Potatoes 14th a cold Day 15th Put up the
Quilt Lashy here Jim Hopkins came from Lancaster down
with 3 Passengers 17th Jim Hopkins took away his horses
drew up the stick of Pine and some Logs out of the
River Gordon Randolph and I went up with them
took dinner at Hopkins 18th went to the R.
stopt at the Lighthouse 19th 2 Indians here looking
for a canoe they lost with the wind gave them their
Breakfast High Wind Raining 20th Drawing wood
21st Last Day of Summer 22nd First Day of Autumn Went
to 4 Covington wrote a Letter in Concord to John 23rd Drawing
Wood 24th Mowing Marsh Hay Bill and I Plomado here
from Lancaster Mr Spencer all alone here stopt to night
25th Mr Spencer went to Summerstown hauled out
his Boat as there was a piece of Iron catching on the
Bottom and we fixed it One of the sheep shot 26th
I caught the Sheep killed it and went over with
2 of the Cotton to Thomas Munroe & McDonald
and I down together to Roses he had Tennet for Butter went
to Roses got some Apples 27th
28th A very very fine Day Went down to the Red Red Gordon
and I took Dick and was very comfortable
seen a Weasal there 29th St Michael
and all angles 30th Mowing in the Trout Marsh
John Hamilton here with his Lighthouse Book
so him and I fixed it as well as we could
