We weighed some pigs this morning in the crate one at a time after being fed intending to kill them then weigh them dressed and find the shrink. They were as follows 1, 174 2 3,230 4,209 ophan Annie 275. I drove down town before dinner to see about getting Tom Mills to help kill pigs also fare to Burgessville etc etc spent 1st part and Paid J. M. Co in full for Fanning Mill \$32.00 hauled load manure to No 7 in P.M. </p>			32 00	1

<p> Fine day sunny most of day blue sky thawing some. Wilkie went down with team in morning brought up Tom Mills also selling troughs etc We killed and dressed 10 pigs to-day. I drove Tom down at night went to Jim Sandersons where he and J. M. Hardy audited books which Jim Gingrich brought. I paid Tom \$1.00 cash Aunt Mary and Mont Parker drove down for dinner went down town with Jim then went home before tea. Mr Goss over in evening. </p>			1 00

<p> Rain and sleet last night and early A.M. cleared off fine sunny P.M. Thawing most day. Wilkie and Mr Goss went to Mills took troughs and other stuff back and brought some hay for Goss. I went to school meeting acted as chairman Bob Sindle put in as auditor Byrs & M. Hardy trustees. Wilkie got Jimmie Haddie 18 lbs. We hauled 3 loads manure to No 7 P.M. Mrs Quarrie up in P.M. to see get all shelf fixed Wilkie went down at night to fix it took something with him </p>			18
