(159-206)

It was nice we fitted up the root ground and some corn ground we sowed some corn east of the barn It was a nice day Fred and Mattie called here for Fred to spare Daniel and Margoy called here the children and I went to Sunday school and church Mr Warren Drecht Fred got his book for gathering Missionary
