Raining in morning cloudy day. Willi went for meat this morning Jess in buggy I took barley corn potatoes turnips apples pens down to show about noon. Willi dropped pig. Willi went down to show at night admittance 10

cloudy and sunny mostly cloudy. Willi went to Geo Ferguson got Service corn binder A.M. I went down got some medicine from Dr Armstrong also 60 box salve. I got dinner at home. We all at show P.M. got 1st prize on barley potatoes and crows Jim's admittance 50 cts
