 Mr Gordon's & Mr Lane's families  
 came to see us this afternoon.

Saturday 18<sup>th</sup> Soft & showery  
 we worked around barn  
 cleaned some grain out  
 I went to town in afternoon  
 recd checks for \$29.00 & P.O.  
 order for \$12.00 bgt rubber  
 for Junie 50¢ gro 22 50  
 sold eggs 74¢ 77 32  
 had a letter from Mr Clement  
 Stephenson,

Sunday 19<sup>th</sup> fine  
 Father, Mary & I went to church  
 heard Rev J's Path on add  
 to your Faith Knowledge a  
 very good sermon took  
 children to S.S.

Monday 20<sup>th</sup> fine  
 we did chores and hauled  
 two loads manure. I went to  
 town in afternoon. Sent \$100.00  
 from mother to Will & sent  
 73 lbs of hens at 8¢ 5.84  
 pd for draft for Will 15¢ 15

Tuesday 21<sup>st</sup> full  
 we did chores and  
 hauled 5 lbs manure  
 went to Jas Laidlow's funeral  
 in afternoon.

Wednesday 22<sup>nd</sup> full  
 I went in to sell and  
 two gentlemen. Mr John Lowe  
 from Elora & Mr Beattie  
 from Blair came to see bulls  
 sold V.P. Ringlades to Mr Lowe  
 Mr Cressman was also here to see Billy
