Very warm day again mostly sunny clouded over P M like rain. Willie harrowed T L field a m and I shingled henhouse. P M we brought over load buckwheat but considered it too green so put in rest of day at henhouse. Father up P M. Mr Gass over in evening paid us on acct of Miss Robson's rails \$5.00

Thursday

Exceedingly warm day. We lent Mr Gass Kate & Dan to plow his land but it was so warm and they sweat so much he brought them back. I dug top out of last extension of ditch No 2 E from spring up till M Willie downtown got at Boys groceries 20 shingle nails Menus 20 lime Gw 2 buck 50 separator oil Ramson's 10cts. P M Willie shingled henhouse I hauled 2 load stones light waggon mixed some mortar and built some more of henhouse foundation. Lizzie M. Donald up for tea. Very warm dry weather yet grass keeps green.
