W. Mild Cloudy began to snow (very soft)
about dinner time, turned to rain
very sloppy, quite mild
9 A visit to Spink Mills, A.M. he caught
2 Bench Flour @ \$3.80 per Bbl. I do not
feel well he & Henry took 10 bgs grist to
Pt. N. A.M. Henry took road scraper to
Left & brought grist home P.M.
W. Mild some soft snow after dark
This is Nancy's 62nd Birthday
10 Henry helped Flair A.M. I went
to Cedar Grove A.M. A. & Henry
Delia & fixed a few parts of the
single harness that I bought at
Gelschmidt's Dale A finished a butter
for Colt Green. Hermon was here to
dinner W. Mild about 4 in soft
snow, pretty fair strong breeze I took
4 1/2 lbs hand to Cedar Grove @ 12th per
lb our 4 hogs yielded about 375 lbs of lard
11 Henry & Adeline helped Ben's kill hogs
A Chores I went to Markham

with Flair he got some Medicine
for himself, Flair was helping Ben's kill
hog & cut himself across his hand & cut
the cord of his first finger, the Dr fixed
& bandaged it for him, Mary & Anne
went to Markham in Cutler Pass
pretty fair strong breeze, Anthony Dorr
& wife were here P.M. W. fine & mild
2 Henry helped Thomas kill hog, a Chores he
helped one of my everyday boots I took Butter
& eggs to Cedar Grove Albert Reason bought
Plover Rittenhouse & his wife while P.M.
they are newly married, Hermon called P.M.
he asked Nancy & me to come to a Turkey
Roast tomorrow, we intend to go if it is
a fine day & I feel able, I am not very well
W. fine & mild, throwing a little
3 Henry helped David Reason kill hog, a helped
Delia, Beans Thrush for Thomas, I Chores
4 & Nancy went to Hermon to Turkey
Roast W. Mild Cloudy rain from
about noon till about 2 P.M.
then clearing, coming home W. mild
5 Henry helped Thomas, a Chores & cut a
Butcher Knife out of a piece of old Lane's Tooth
6 A.M. he helped Flair P.M. W. drizzly
rain A.M. pretty heavy P.M. began to freeze
towards evening, getting quite cold
ice freezing on the trees
