a very fine Day Filled a Tack with corn -
Trunks put some corn stalks in the Barn drew
some Boards over to the Pitt Point took over the
Wheat Box Stanley went with Ed Renshaw
to make a Stack on Francis Island Lewis
the Indian here got salt and Matches iron
for a Gaff Fernandez to Lancaster Done
Tracing the Corn this Morning Seen a Wild
Goose Gordon came 17th St Lamberts Day
Leander and Minnie to Church Wrote Gordon's
Name in his Bible Gordon crossed 18th June
Began taking up the Potatoes put 56 -
Bushels in the cellar to Day of Bur Banks
Fernandez for Lime Ed Renshaw for Stanley
19th Raining East Wind Lucias here for
Potatoes peck 12 1/2 Salt 5 20th Equinoctial
Gales about this Time SW Crossing the
Line East Wind Rained got a Sturgeon
Lucias for Butter 6 lb at 18 cents / 08 Boy
at the Bush and cellar Oliver Monice
Supposed to Be Drowned as his Boat
was found 21st some Wet put in 32 Bushels
to Day that's 88 Bushels in the cellar now Dig-
ging Stones on the Pitt Point Fernandez for Lime
So going here to tell about over St. Matthews
Day

James Cameron Island 22nd Sept 1899
Black Friday Stanley and Fernandez for Lime
Taking up Potatoes Finished the Bur Banks
Gordon and Leander crossed got a Hedgehog
23rd Fine E Wind Finished West the Head
Began the piece Below the Corn there is
210 Bushels up now to Day Sissy and Minnie
Crossed a Basket of Eggs seen 5 Movers to Day
Blue Jays came Sugar (223) 24 Sunday Windy
Leander and Minnie to Church stopt with the
Wind tonight Rained 25th Fine some Drops of
Rain Leander came this Morning Drawing stones
to the cellar I went to the Head of the Island
to Salt the Sheep I and Jona fishing Perch
for to Bait the Line caught a Lot but its Windy
Leander crossed Minnie come Back with him
Rained very heavy to night 26th Raining all
Day East and West Wind got 4 Sturgeon this
Morning one 6 1/4 lb Fernandez went to So Semays
27th West Wind Rained Fernandez went with the
Sturgeon to So Semays Wrote a Letter to
John Cameron Junction City Kansas U S to Day
Ed Renshaw here 28th Fine W Wind Building the
cellar Wall Drawing Stone Broke the Line
and Found it Leander crossed sent a Letter
and 2 papers and a Plug of Leather to Cameron
