Percussion of the Pulmonary Apices-No. 1.

Pulmonary tuberculosis begins as an infiltration and not as a catarrh. It can therefore be recognized in its early stages by the detection of small airless areas of lung tissue at the apices. When auscultatory signs make their appearance, it is an indication that the infiltrate has softened, and broken through a bronchus, and the case can no more be considered incipient.—Fishberg; Med. Record.
