We drove down to Jno Cordiers in AM with Jess in cutter to see his horses he is having sale tomorrow. In PM Willie drove May down he took farming mill to Guarin then brought up load manure from Guarin we spread it on No 1. Mother up in PM Willie drove her down and brought up Mary who had been at Dr Reids getting teeth fixed. Mary got spools at Steels 9 cts clock at Marshalls fixed 15 cts. Mrs Wansborough called in PM in cutter with their new she screeled home Mr W. drove her.

Thursday

Very frosty sunny and cloudy snowing some PM. We cut corn in AM and in P.M. drove down to Jno Cordiers sale with Jess in cutter his 5 yr old mare sold for \$10.00 to G.S.D. Hill.

Friday

Exceedingly frosty day clear sunny. I hauled two loads manure from Steels to-day to No 1 spread. Mary down at Reids in AM got teeth filling finished. Drove down with Lucy in cutter in PM took 16 lbs butter over to Mrs McVicar on apr @ 21 cts \$3.36 got wormwood 6 cts sold get mild to Carl Bunting 3 cts

Fine sunny day frosty. Willie and I and Bob Indale went to Sulphur with Jack & Jess & his horse to try sell them Bob sold his for \$5.00 we brought ours back. expenses 75 cts I returned my couplings got at Bonds last year 72 cts. Bob sold to Pennyfather We had Wm. Malch sleigh. Bob. his old cutter
