- 17. Elsie Cameron buried today. Lizzie Brown called
- 18. Mrs Burgess buried today. Cold weather Jack brought the last of the 1/2 cords of wood. He was paid 82.00 sitting for cord 80.00 drawing 81.00 - 1.30 - 1.20 - 2.30 - 80 to pay yet
- 19. Fine bright day. Mary Gore called, had 1 bot syrup, chunk of veal. Birdie called
- 20. Fine day Pa not up today. Sandy Henry was buried today. Mrs Grant of Cornwall v. M. Elder called
- 21. Fine Mrs Grant had Josephines, baby, 5 years old, with her 70 1 gall coal oil 1 pan bread 20.00 1 box biscuit 25.00 Pa Pa is wandering in his memory.
- 22. Thomas sowed wheat on village farm. Jimmie went to Sandy Dargwall's (mason) and got 3 lbs. ^{birdie} had to go on village farm, but at McCreannons 15 lbs clover 12.00 for birdie.
- 23. Fine day. Pa is a little better
- 24. Jimmie drew some old timber from farm. Mutter 3 lbs
- 25. Fine day. To 1 lb tea 30.00 bread 20.00 Mrs Stewart called, so did Mrs D. Campbell. Jimmie caught two fish. Jimmie paid Mc Gregor 75 for the apples

- 26. Fine day. Birdie came in afternoon to remain for a few days. Did not send the offering
- 27. Mother Donoula paid 85.00 for rent. Birdie took down the lace curtains and put them to sleep. Mary called. Daisy was in for a few minutes
- 28. Fine day. Bruce McLennan, Duncan King son who died in Calgary was buried here today. Annie McLennan, Squere spent the afternoon here. Birdie was sending to Eaton's for things I sent 1.00 for Charles more food 45.00 for Cotton oil 18 for kumale pills 55 for Stationary 70 out meal 25.00 paid Jimmie 75 that he paid for apples. To pan bread 20.00 80.00 for postage & postal note. Jimmie took 8 bush out to Mayor, John Robertson there
- 29. To Mayor 8 bush out. Cash of 2.40 to buy busby
- 30. Muddy drove Birdie home last evening. This has been a dry hot day, with high wind Mercury 81 in the shade, Mrs 1/2 day To soap 10 Mrs Alpin Clark was buried today

On the 29th there were a number of barns in the neighborhood of North Lancaster, burnt, all caught fire from the first one sitting fire to the next, and so on.
