Sat June 4<sup>th</sup> clear part of the day and hot 90 deg in the shade Bilton calld and was here most of the fore noon

Fri June 10<sup>th</sup> cloudy most of the day and cool Sarah here doing house work. Mary calld in this after noon going to see Mrs. Browder. I started to go to the old home met Dick and came back

Sat June 11<sup>th</sup> clear and warm. Edwin Young and Walter Snarey was here getting corn to plant. not doing much my self

Sun June 12<sup>th</sup> clear and hot

Mon June 13<sup>th</sup> clear and hot. was sprinkling Currant bushes. and Shelling seed corn for Mrs. Brown So on
