28th I got G. N. Sheffield's money order cashed \$6.44^{cts} this is \$4.00 more than he owed me I sent him a receipt and the one dollar I lent Jas. Brown \$25.00 on a note for 2 Mo. s. with Int. a 6% until paid

29th We settled the brick machine trouble to-day Geo. was here alday was a nice day but cold

30th I took mother out home I gave her \$5.00 and she gave it to Dora had dinner at Jims came back to R. Moultons Mrs Moulton came in with me was an awfull cold day.

31st I lent Annie 25 cts. she paid it back to Mary I got a lb of tea 25 cts Ab. Sly and wife were down in eve we gave them \$2.50 of a wedding present was a nice day have left to night \$26.43 cts

Feb 1st It snowed about 1 ft last night and is snowing yet there is about 2 ft. of snow fell last night to-day I gave Dr. Bird 75 cts for medicine for Mary 12 cts for peanuts & candy it snowed alday.

2nd was a nice day but windy

3rd I wrote in Diary to-day 20 cts for cream of wheat went to lodge this eve paid my dues to July 1st 1908 \$3.00 paid my Ins. on stock at shop \$4.35 cts was a cold day.
