1 New Years day. Fine bright frosty morning, trees coated with rime, clouded over got stormy and snowing by night Willie brought up 7.M. and Auntie in cutter then went down for Uncle Jim and Mrs Ritchie they were here for dinner and tea. Mrs Hayward came up P.M. stayed for tea. I drove them down in evening in sleigh.

Saturday

2 Snowing, got quite stormy by night. Willie dug out hole where turnips were rotting in roothouse and I clipped hair of backs and tails of cattle A.M. we chopped cow P.M.

Sunday

3 Sunny and cloudy. frosty. Mr Brown preached A.M. from Acts 27:22 first dance a New Years sermon and in evening from Genesis 3:24 We gave ch coll \$52.50 balance 1914 also girls \$2.00 balance 1914.

Monday

4 Fine sunny day. thawing some in sunshine
1880 We hauled 6 loads manure back to sand hill made new pile foundation with them. one load from pig pen one from box stall rest from yard
Willie drove Bella & Mary down P.M. he paid Michel for coal got last Wednesday 9.60 also halter etc 45cts he also got at Worders halter 135 knots put out 25.
I drove down to prayer meeting in St James church at night Punch in cutter left her in St Lukes shed unhooked as she pulls on rope. She girls don't
