Henry Mary & Anne went to Peter Reason  
to dinner W. Sharp east wind strong  
towards evening began to snow after dark  
4 Boys Chored I went to Hebron to make  
Meeting there were only myself Mr Ben  
B's N & his son Albert so the three of us  
were appointed last year will serve  
W. Sharp wind & snow from east  
wind toward south on the Pass

Feb 1901  
A went to Cedar Grove P.M. B's  
has La Grippe he is some better  
5 A & Henry Shelled Corn we had Albert  
Shellers Henry Adeline & Mary went  
to Johnny Reason's to supper Mrs Burrows  
Called Flavin's & Ben's called this  
morning W. Cold strong N wind  
roads drifted some East & west  
6 Boys Chored Shelled a little Corn  
I had a bad spell at dinner time  
A went for Dr he came this evening  
he changed his Medicine W pretty  
Cold a little below zero this morning  
7 A oiled Harness Henry packed  
Chicken & gave I a dinner in the  
Cutter he about it well Henry  
took Butter Eggs & Chicken  
to Lewis P.M. I rode with him  
as far as P.O. he is getting better  
W. a good deal milder cloudy  
8 Henry Mary & Anne took a sleigh  
load of our Neighbors to Mount  
Joy Singing School this evening  
we cut some feet then a took grit Chop  
to B's D's A.M. a took I to see Dr he says  
he is doing well thy came by Daniels little  
Lewis is not very well Esther has Grippe too
