	4	<p>Friday</p> <p>Very warm day sunny and cloudy few drops rain in P.M. some thunder at night. We planted 4 more rows potatoes A.M. then bagged up rest of potatoes for sale. Willie took them down after dinner 2150 lbs @ 70 cts bag 1672 also 12 doz eggs @ 18 \$2.16 got 4 lbs turnips and 88 balance on off. weighing 10 cts after he came back we planted rest of potatoes 4 more rows 3 of them Sir Walter Raleigh except 12 ft row top of 1st row of these and last row common Willie down town at night got sugar 10 cts</p>

Then Willie plowed some shores &amp; drained. anchored port. Sold 2 stons Jerry &amp; I came to Black &amp; Wheatland from \$93.00 to go Monday got \$1.00. May came P.M. got at Brading, see off green \$1.70 gloves at Shands \$1.00 Wm. Clark got eggs 45 cts. I went down town at night paid Miss Brooks for spray got for milk pins found \$2.00 put cards &amp; cokes at 12 cts 15</p>
