Friday

Frost last night. A little sunshine & M mostly cloudy very windy, not very frosty. snowing a little at times. We spread 4 loads manure on No 2 turnip land E of elm tree then Willie plowed corn stubble No 1. I plowed manured land No 2. Mary got ride up this morning with Jackson (baker) she brought up church reports from J.C.P. and we set up till 12 o'clock or nearly filling them in.

Mary sent away Eaton Order \$26.45 - cost of water
24 do 12 do she also got stamps 12 do. Girls got 2000 interest \$20.00 20 00 12 12

Saturday

Frost last night Fine Indian summer day mostly sunny thawing a little. Willie took old sheep in wate in wagon and let Quavie behind over to Joe Brown

Lelan got balance \$45.50 got coal oil, 2 1/2 gallons cylinder oil, separator oil from Columbus
8 00 car at station on way home paid for all \$8.00 45 50 2 50 5 50

I finished plowing the turnip and mangel land E of elm tree No 2 also finished corn stubble piece No 1 thus finishing the most important part of our plowing. Willie dropped some. Willie and Mary walked down town at night. Mary stayed down. We brought over small load hay.

Sunday

Mostly cloudy, row east wind. not frosty. rained a little at night. Mr Graw preached AM from a sermon on Training children and in evening from Minnie Sanderson and her husband called down at home in evening.
