Hard frost last night, fine sunny day. almost warm. Willie took sow over to Bowdys then we panned up the last row of potatoes harvested out some turnips and brought over 2 waggon box loads turnips. P.M. we finished our turnips and potatoes 5 loads one of them turnip box load finished by moonlight. road getting bad. Barber had Punch this A.M. Willie went down 2 70 town at eight got hair cut Grahams 20. got at Russells undershirt and drawers \$2.50.

1 Fine A.M., thunder lightning and rain P.M. also in evening. Mr Cran preached A.M. from "Buy the Truth and sell it not" and in evening from Luke 11: 5 to 10. I.D. Allans took 50
Only Willie and I home A.M. all down at eight.

Cloudy chilly day. Willie took sow No 2 over to Bowdys A.M. then he chopped pig. I started to plow sand hill across, repairing plowed row. P.M. I drove Bella and father up to Aggie Hardis funeral I got 2 yds garden Chapman 40cts. Willie plowed sand hill P.M. I paid Gubritt in full \$1.00. Scheris had load of our waggons to-day to haul down turnips. We drove up
