- Augt 11 I went to Dr. vase & got some small in the
grainfield because of water & we got to the store
it is I caught the way for home and sat.
Be machine being off here we were late
I am cut the pieces that we left for me it is the same
as a piece of the northeast field. Had a meeting
from 10 to 11 in the New Home meeting place
that 3 went to Marble Rock & examined the alluvium
of road near of 3rd corner man between State
out the old Marble Rock road warm day
picked potato bags of the potatoes in the Middle
field & worked on the summer fallow
yesterday & to day
5. AD went to Abram W. Kels for a load of
straw back to the road
6. the Rev H. Walker preached in the morning &
trouble at night warm day
7. AD drew chips from Thorng's woods to see
Billie & W. Heacock went on the express for Party
round to day. Went to the council with report of it
8. riged the sawing machine and saved cordwood
in the forenoon Wallace Bruce & a son
9. began the honest cut the oats South half
of the north field very warm day
10. Owen & Wallace cut apart of the middle
field with the scythe & forevee finished the field
in the forenoon they went home Wallace &
Me raked part of the north field AD come
out with the horse rake & take the part of the
middle field that was cut down in two loads of it
& one load of the north field
11. Owen Wallace & AD raked & drew in 5 loads
of the north field & fixed the pump at the fit
for to water the cattle the water is ready
12. AD worked with Bruce & the 1 water & see
13. Margaret came on the express this afternoon over from Boston
I took Waller to his for the morning he preached again
