We came home after dinner a while on account of rain. Willie hauled 2 loads manure from Franks to pile A.M. P.M. we laid some more cement floor in Pigpen.

Girls and I drove down at night they went along home with Lucy I went to managers meeting they discussed getting a pipe organ appointed a canvassing committee We got home at midnight

Wednesday

Fine sunny day, frost last night cool air today but yesterday's snow casting thawed off. Willie hauled 2 loads manure from Franks to pile on A.M. and in P.M. we both drove over to Elora horse show Jess in buggy. Rogerson got third for his imported mare Sargent first for his black standard bred stallion etc. We paid Hastings 25 cts for privilege of tying Jess to post in his living. Mand sprained her hind leg today getting down in stall on hard wood.

Very fine sunny spring like day warm. I went to Crables in A.M. again helped with churning. Willie brought load manure from Franks also load wood from hardwood bush. In P.M. we plowed some in No 7 stump field and scaded down and bed with white wood. Willie took Jersey to Franks P.M. Bob Dindale drove at night to send our milk canner to tell how to put his together. I got ride up to Crables with Jim Able gave him \$1.00 extra on sale purchase. Got from Bens on 13th 5 cts milk.
