April

- 18 fixed the wheel of the wheelbarrow fine day
- 19 fine rain last night & most of the day the grass is green this is the first rain we have had this month
- 20 Ad come out & we cleaned up 25 bushel of oats raining still about 10 o'clock it snowed so that the ground is all covered white.
- 21 Vera killed the two lambs that we had & tied horn up & he being himself we have no dog now
- 22 Rev W Freshman preaches this morning & W Mc Gill very at night fine warm day
- 23 Ad plow in the summer fallow it is hardly dry enough yet then he sowed 10 bushel of oats on the southeast quarter of the north field fine warm day every thing is growing.
- 24 I sowed nearly a bushel of Themaby seed on the same field Ad finished grass dragging it the fine
- 25 Sowed 13 bushel of oats and 3 bushel of <sup>oats</sup> in center field east half fine day
- 26 Sowed 1 bushel of wheat in center field next ditch & 3 1/2 on the road east side of the first pi & 2 bushel of the Norway oats same pi
- 27 Ad sowed 7 1/2 bushel of oats in the old house field fine day I dug some in the garden
- 28 Bilker come from Delta in the night he brought Bessie with him & 50 bushel of oats he helped Ad to harrow in the old house field him and Wallace finished the day by noon Ad cleaned out the water from rows in the first field & ~~and~~ middle field heavy rain in the afternoon
- 29 Rev W Ferguson preaches in the p.m. & W Stewart at night
- 30 Ad plowed in the north field where summer fallow was he could not do it last fall W Ferguson here all night
