We hauled back 5 loads manure to send tail pile in sleigh I chopped some pig. with the maywood up at noon to tell us Codys thrashing outfit was coming here to night which it did Messrs Pat Brennan and Dan Sullivan with it they stayed all night. With down town Park in buggy got at 7 o'clock bread

Cloudy and sunny windy and a few drops rain A.M. got frost by night no frost last night. We thrashed till about noon commencing 1/4 to 9 when separator broke Pat & Dan went away after dinner to see get repairs. We had following hands D Allan, Cook, Maywood, D Meade, S Meade Jameson & J. Ford. P.M. we chopped some. We got turnips out of feed room enough to get silage right down. Andrew Searns got pint new milk. Mother up A.M. went down again at noon.

Fine sunny Indian Summer day frosty but thawing in sunshine. We got manure spreader fixed up and spread 7 loads on No 6 at other barn 4 from barnyard and pig pen and 3 from sandhill pile. With went around road by S.D. with last load spread from gate down 1 load per acre. I chopped 3 kinds. With down town at night. paid nickel for coal got yesterday 68 cts
