## Infantile Ileocolitis.

In "putrefactive diarrhea" of infants, all irritating food should be avoided as, by causing increased mucous flow, it favors bacterial pullulation. Use of proteid of cow's milk, obtained by removing whey from skimmed milk with chymogen or pepsin, advisable. Break up curd into fine particles and suspend in 5 per cent. gelatin water, to be heated before administration. After four or five days to a week replace gelatin water partly by buttermilk, and skimmed-milk curds by whole-milk curds, gradually getting child on albumin-milk and finally on whole-milk mixture.—Grulee.
