6. Whenever under reasonably vigorous treatment the patient does not improve, induce labor.

7. In the presence of actual convulsions: (a) If the cervix is open apply forceps or do version; (b) if the cervix is closed do vaginal or abdominal Cæsarian section; (c) avoid the strain of labor.

8. Gas is the anesthetic of choice for operative procedure, next ether; never chloroform.—Skeel; *Cleveland Med. Journ.*
