day I went to Flavin's P.M.
21 Ben helped girls pick Chickens cut feet
& A took Oats to Bo. D's A.M. A mended
Harness & Henry took Butter Eggs & Chickens
to Lewis's P.M. I went to Locust Hill
for money for wheat A.M. he is pretty
well these few days W. sharp clear
A.M. fleecies of snow P.M. the little
fleecies of snow patch the slighting
very well
22 I & Henry cleaned last of wheat
about 11 bus & the 20th Century Oats
A wheeled the Oats out of west barn
on bag track the dust of the grain
gives him the asthma I escaped
away he is pretty well just now
Dorothy & Russell came to dinner Lewis
is not well enough to come yet
