Fine in a.m rained at intervals all p.m. got very windy at night. Wm Indale up 3²¹/₄ of a day he hauled back 3 loads manure in a.m and rolled some of turnip land. Malcolm and I set most of fence posts in a.m. I went down to Froot paid for flour got on Saturday and groceries in all \$2.04. Got post card from Will posted in Owen Sound before sailing.
