## Malignant Disease and Pernicious Anemia.

Between malignant disease and pernicious anemia the diagnosis depends on the following:

First, leucocytosis often increased in malignant disease, but diminished in pernicious anemia.

Second, in malignancy the color index is low, while in pernicious anemia it is invariably high.

Third, lymphocytes usually are decreased in malignancy, but increased in pernicious anemia.

Fourth, if nucleated red corpuscles are present the normoblasts are in a majority in malignant disease, but in a minority in pernicious anemia.—R. N. Andrews; St. Paul Medical Journal.
