There were 3 quart scales of fine crabapples and 2 pint and 1 quart scales of citron.

29th I was in church Rev Mr Hastie preached a good Thanksgiving sermon. My off 25.
 30. Bright and fine. 4 lb butter from factory
 31. Rain today. Got factory receipt. There is 42 lb cheese charged to us 13.⁰⁰ - Paid 4. 34
 Wednesday I got a letter from Farguhar with \$14.25 - being from the Bell Telephone Co.

- 1 Thursday Kind of Stormy. The W. F. M. I met here today 1 gall coal oil 17
- 2 Well notwithstanding the ugly day, we had 9 at our meeting. Pay off 25.⁰⁰ tea 5
- 3 Snowing.
- 4 Dull day. 70 4 loaves 24.⁰⁰ 3 lb steak charged at Sandy's
- 5 I did not go to church. Birdie went. Sent my off in evening by Jimmie
- 6 Bot at Willie's sale 3 lbs currants 25.⁰⁰ 3 lbs raisins 50
 Orange peel lemon and citron 1 lb biscuit 39
 70 3 loaves 18.⁰⁰ Flora Ann Christie here to dinner 70 candy 5. Murdy went north 5
- 7 Quite frosty today. J. P. came for his folk today. Mrs St Thomas paid \$2.00 for rent - 70 3 loaves 12
 70 candy 5.⁰⁰
- 8 Cold last night. Duncan McThurson was buried today. he died Monday night. John his brother was down, he looks well. I sent an order to Eatons \$29. 76. and an order for Birdie \$5.00 Got a 4 cakes
- 9 Birdie was down to the sale, she bot for me wafle 25
- 10 I was sending a letter to Marion to Vancouver and a Post Office order for \$25.00. There was no one at home so I had to go out myself. I went to the sale, and bot 2 lbs G. sugar 1.⁰⁰ 6 lbs B sugar 25 - 1. 25
 4 lbs pulverized sugar 25. 8 lbs rice 25 - 2 lbs - 50
 macaroni 16. 1 broom 30, mixtures 5. Liquid veneer 39 80
 11 Fine bright day, killed 3 roosters and turkey hen. Jimmie went collecting, north. 70 3 loaves 18 1 lb biscuits 9
- 12 I have a cold did I did not go to church, sent \$2.⁰⁰ When Birdie was down on Friday, she brought us 1/4 of a nice sized pig. the ham end. The weather keeps very cold. My both away. They come home at night.
