22 Saturday. Warm. The men brought in 3 loads this a.m. We threshed this p.m. and these men were here - Harry Rennie, Eber. Stickney, Enoch Snider, Louis Miller, Joe Nelson and Alf. Fromhold. Eva Snider spent the afternoon with Ella & helped.
