Rain very foggy Blackbirds  
came Unfortunate Day some  
few men working at the pier  
yesterday the 11<sup>th</sup> Water on the ice  
Bought 3 spools of thread 15 cents  
Stanley not very well ON  
This Day of the of the Month  
D. Mr. Master Senior first came  
to the Island and the  
ice opened this day very very  
foggy calm I had to make  
this big or I cant make out  
thru again the next Day Rained  
hard to night Lots of Water on the ice  
cut a hole for perch 13<sup>th</sup> Raining  
snowed some Randall here  
took down the star East and North  
month The Boers Beating the 3<sup>rd</sup> mill  
in the East route they had by  
Having on 13<sup>th</sup> mittish cloths Stanley  
in well The ice men Borning on the ice  
14<sup>th</sup> Stanley's Birth Day 1880 fine  
Day went to the lower point Made  
shuts for the old Bob sleigh Stanley  
not well took over the park over  
fine to day I drew 4 bags of wood to  
the Bank Randolf and Rossle came at  
the shore and Rossle came at  
Summerton

James Cameron Island 15<sup>th</sup> March 1902  
East wind fine sunshiny Day cool a  
sale at Mr. Chisholm's to Day Stanley  
very unwell Dont take any nourishment  
at all his head is what the complaint  
of drawing those bridge sticks  
Bank then to Summerton 2 of  
them drew on the south side from  
Wharf Whistlers flying a lot of shooting  
on the south side Thawing this  
afternoon London came to night  
Chisholm's sale put off till the 19<sup>th</sup>  
16<sup>th</sup> Sunday Unfortunate Day fine  
Day Randall and I Spunk came  
Stanley very unwell to day and to  
night he is very bad very bad  
slept well the boys making  
at the air hole set decoys shot  
6 ducks 2 a piece Rained hard  
to night some wind 17<sup>th</sup> of this  
to the 17<sup>th</sup> of Ireland of Patrick's Day  
fine cool Pleasant after ducks  
at the air hole Stanley no better  
Dont take any nourishment at  
all took Baths and shools to the  
Bush froze to night Stanley poorly  
18<sup>th</sup> St. Joseph's Day fine on this  
Day of the month Chicker departed  
1884 Rowena Randolf here for Ran kept  
Went to San Carlos sent for Ran kept  
essence of pepper mint eye water  
gave him a Dollar
