 cloudy AM fine sunny PM but cold day.
 Edith Dix. Carrie Semple and Miss McKee
 married to-day also another wedding. I plowed
 No 6 in AM and Willie got tooth filled at
 Reids paid him in full \$1.00. In PM Willie
 plowed No 6 and I pulled rest of pease. We
 brought over two loads corn to-day.

Thursday

Very hard frost last night fine sunny day.
 Willie took straw down to Bosse also 12 bushels
 and brought up load manure which I spread
 on J.L. field. In PM he took 25 bushels
 oats down to mill for J. Chapman @ 34d bushel
 and brought up load manure from Steels & spread it
 We brought over 2 loads corn and rest of pease load
 we plowed in No 6 all day. Mary down town
 in PM got at Steels dress goods 27th express ordering 8.00
 Mary sent \$5.00 to Ada Fater for wedding present.
 Mother up in PM.

Cloudy and sunny to-day Jack Dix
 and Jim Clark over in AM we farmed and
 bagged 3488 lbs oats for former at 10c/lb. 36.85
 we also bought from Hamilton 6 bags 115 lbs
 In PM Willie took load wood and 2
 bags hen feed home and brought up load manure
 from Bosse also Black Hawk grinding mill express 35
 We plowed in No 6 in PM I spread the load manure
 J.L. then brought over 2 loads corn. Mary went
 down to manse at night to social.
