Corbett slab & helped Lu. to strap it up
Ralph brought it out in after-noon
I fixed it & cleaned & cemented two others
for L. M. I. Earl & one for R. L. Larkin

Mr. Larkin paid me for Corbett
slab \$2. and \$1 to cement two others
in the next time I am out Mr.
Earl owes me \$2.50 for what I done
for him my dinner at Athens 50cts
20cts for cement had tea Mr. Boyce came
home gave Lu. \$1.25 for his work it
~~B. Shook left \$1 with Jack for me~~
was a nice day

14th I gave Jim \$2.50 came to Town
brought my two rigs in loaded day
job on Gonyon's waggon went down
Erected it in after-noon got home about
half past eight there is \$60 coming on
it 10cts for bolt repairs was a nice
day rained a little to night

15th I gave Ed. Gonyon \$2 for his trip
yesterday I have this morning \$170.20
got ready came out to see Jas. Walker
got his note for \$57 at 6% for 3 mos.
came on out finished filling Henderson
