- May 17 Planted 12 bushel of potatoes at crestes Mr Lawton planted  
a piece with us I went to the funeral of Mr Labor  
Broth he was buried at the Booth Burying place  
there were 90 buggys & carriages the Rev Mr W<sup>rs</sup> Gungy  
ran
- 18 planted part of the corn & sowed nearly 2 k bushel  
of oats on the Rye ground & 1 k bushel of wheat  
on the fall wheat ground when they were  
killed out fine showers this afternoon
- rain  
show 19 finished planting at crestes corn & potato  
in fine rain to day every thing look well  
Rev Mr W<sup>rs</sup> Kizer preached at canton
- 20  
morn 21 drew dung to orchard for turneps fine day
- first  
22 sowed the great chiller potatoes & sowing of the next 1/2 sowing potatoes  
23 finished the plowing in the orchard planted 4 bushel
- 24 went to Mr Inlocks Mill with 2 bushel of corn  
& 14 of wheat & drew a load Boards dove  
went Mallorytown to training Adams went  
Farmer will great workes to be done
- 25 dragged & furrowed the orchard for the turneps
- rain  
26 sowed the turneps 2 k lbs fine rain this morning
- 27  
morn 28 the Rev Mr Mills preached his farewell sermon  
took the roof of the old barn & washed the sheep
- 29 drew the ~~old~~ <sup>or logs of</sup> barn onto the road fine day
- 30 dug part of a ditch next the Barn
- rain  
31 drew stones from the old Barn to the ditch  
a fine rain to night
