

March, 1929.

4 Monday. Mild dreary & foggy. Ezra came over and he and Walter skinned a horse this morning and got another old one this afternoon. Ezra was here for dinner and supper. Vernon drew out some manure.

5 Tuesday. Fair. Cold north wind. Walter took 1 dead and 3 living horses down to Helliard's today. He left before 8 o'clock and got home around 10 p.m. Milton Rice went down with him. Ella did the washing and ironing. Vernon helped for a while this morning. Harvey Reist got the scalding troughs.

6 Wednesday. Cold wind blowing. Ella was at a quilting at Mrs. Cow. Wagner's today. Walter took her down and got her again tonight. It rained hard tonight.

7 Thursday. Fierce blizzard blowing today. Worst storm in years. Mrs. Philip Soehner's funeral was postponed until tomorrow.
